



Department Holds Hearings and Comment Period on Neg Reg Agenda

Today, the Department of Education is holding the first of two public hearings to hear comments on the agenda for the [upcoming negotiated rulemaking](#), currently slated to include borrower defense to repayment and gainful employment. The second hearing will be held on July 12, 2017.
